General Instruction

1. Candidates of only Indian Nationality can apply for these posts.
2. University strives to have a workforce which reflects gender balance and women candidates are encouraged to apply. Such applicants are advised to ensure before applying that they possess essential qualification and experience for the post.
3. Applicant can apply against the advertised post as per above mentioned details only.
4. **Applicants shall be required to make online payment of non-refundable application fee of Rs. 2000/- (for the positions at Sr. No. 01& 02) and Rs. 500/- (for the positions at Sr. No. 03) and must enclose a receipt of non-refundable application fee along with the application.**
5. Application fee is exempted for Women/PwBD/SC/ST/ESM and staff members in active service of Rashtriya Raksha University. Applicant should follow the following procedure to deposit the application fees in the bank account of the University:

6. Applicant who wishes to apply for more than one post will be required TO SUBMIT SEPARATE APPLICATION FORM ALONG WITH SEPARATE APPLICATION FEES. Application fees will be non-refundable in any case.
 7. Incomplete, Late and Email application in any respect will not be entertained and candidature will be considered as In-eligible.
 8. The University will NOT be responsible for non-receipt of application (s) within the stipulated period due to any postal delay/ loss of application/ document sent in transit. Applications received after the last date will NOT be considered.

9. The Experience, age and qualification will be reckoned as on the last date of the application i.e. (13.04.2026)
10. Please note that the appointment to permanent posts shall ordinarily be made for five years including probation period of one year after which the appointee, if confirmed, shall continue to hold his / her appointment subject to the provisions of the Act and the Statutes, till the end of the month in which he/she attains the age of superannuation for the holders of permanent appointment or last date of appointment whichever is earlier, as decided by the Executive Council and/or the Central Government from time to time.
11. Upon successful completion of the first tenure of 5 years, the staff will be given permanent appointment till the age of superannuation as per the Central Government norms.
12. An age relaxation of 5 years over and above the maximum age limit for the staff if in active service at RRU at the time of advertisement.
13. The University strives to have a diversified workforce. All candidates without reference to gender, race, creed, caste or class are encouraged to apply. Female candidates are encouraged to apply in order to promote gender equality, and flexible.
14. The interview structure may involve written test, skill test, personal interview and / or group discussion
15. For the position of "Research and Administrative Assistant" (at Sr.No. 3), the University has the right to conduct various skill tests along with competitive examination.
16. Candidates must ensure before applying that they are eligible according to the criteria stipulated in the advertisement. If the candidate is found ineligible at any stage of recruitment process, he/she will be disqualified and their candidature will be cancelled. Hiding of information or submitting false information will lead to cancellation of candidature at any stage of recruitment.
17. All the appointees including the in-service candidates shall be governed by the National Pension System (NPS) introduced by Govt. of India.
18. In addition to basic pay, Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance and Transport Allowance are payable as per extant rules on the subject. The employees will be eligible for other benefits like Medical, LTC, Children's Education Allowance as per the University norms.
19. The eligibility criteria indicated are bare minimum and a mere fulfillment of the same will not entitle the candidates to be called for an interview. If numbers of applications received are large, the University may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualification and experience higher than that of the minimum prescribed in the advertisement.
20. Candidates applying for more than one post must submit separate applications.
21. The crucial date for determining qualification/ experience shall be 13.04.2026.
22. Experience will be counted only after the date of obtaining the essential academic qualifications. In other words, wherever experience is required for any post, only relevant post-qualification experience will be considered.
23. Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate will only be accepted for determining the age.
24. While applying the candidates should mention their full name as it appears on the Matriculation / Secondary School Certificate. If a candidate has changed his/her name or dropped or added part of his/her name after Matriculation / Secondary School they will have to submit an attested copy of Gazette Notification to this effect.
25. Submission of valid documentary proof in respect of claim of academic qualifications, category and experience is mandatory.
26. The academic qualifications prescribed should have been obtained from recognized Universities / Institutions and recognized/approved by the relevant authorities i.e. UGC / AICTE / Act of Parliament as applicable. If the Candidate holds a foreign university's degree, they must submit a certificate of equivalency issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).

27. If a candidate has obtained a degree from a university that follows a grading system, they should provide the equivalency criteria for conversion or the formula/method used to calculate their percentage and Class/Division, as issued by their university/institute.
28. The University reserves the right to terminate appointment at any time in case of unsatisfactory performance, misconduct or any other administrative reasons/ compulsions.
29. In case of any dispute/ ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final and binding.
30. The candidate will have to perform such other duties and work as assigned by the Rashtriya Raksha University from time to time.
31. The selected candidates on positions sr. no. 1 & 2 must stay inside the Rashtriya Raksha University main campus in the accommodation provided by the university.
32. The University reserves the right to transfer its employees to any campus of Rashtriya Raksha University.
33. The appointment shall be governed by the rules, regulations and/or decisions of the Rashtriya Raksha University.
34. The University reserves the right to draw up reserve panel/waiting list(s), which will be valid for one year from the date of approval of the Competent Authority and may be used for appointments on consequential/new vacancies.
35. In case of any corrigendum/changes/updates pertaining to this advertisement, the same shall be published on the University's website only. Accordingly, all applicants, in their own interest, are advised to regularly visit the University's website.
36. The University reserves the right to revise/reschedule/cancel/suspend the recruitment process without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained.
37. No correspondence or query will be entertained from the candidates regarding the eligibility, status of applications, postal delays, result of exam/interview, selection process and reasons for not being called for interview or selection etc.
38. Candidates working in Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings and Government Funded Institutions are required to submit application through proper channel OR produce No Objection Certificate at the time of Interview.
39. The experience claimed in the application form without a proper experience certificate from the competent authority shall not be given any weightage by merely enclosing the offer letters, relieving letters and the salary slips.
40. Candidates have to produce the original documents at the time of or before appearing in Interview for verification.
41. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the Written Test/Skill Test/ Interview.
42. The University may verify the antecedents through the appropriate authority and, if it is found that the candidate has suppressed any material information or convicted by any court of law, then his/her service shall be liable to be terminated at any stage.
43. If at any stage, the documents related to educational qualification, experience, category, age, etc. submitted by candidates or any information given by the candidate in the application form/declaration are found to be fake/ false/ misleading, then his/her service shall be liable to be terminated.
44. The candidature at any stage of the selection process will be purely provisional subject to condition that candidate should meet the prescribed eligibility criteria. Mere issue of call letter to the candidate for attending the Written Test/Skill Test/Interview will not imply that his/her candidature has been found eligible.
45. In case of any mistake occurring inadvertently in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of the offer letter, the University reserves the right to withdraw/cancel/modify any communication made to the candidates.
46. Canvassing in any form and/or bringing any influence, political or otherwise, will be treated

as a disqualification from the post applied for.

47. Candidates must be in sound health. They must, if selected be prepared to undergo such medical examination and satisfy such medical authority as the University may require.
48. No person shall be recruited unless he/she is in good mental and physical health and free from any physical defect that is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his official duties.
49. Experienced applicants are highly encouraged to apply.
50. Applications incomplete in any respect and not accompanied by relevant certificate/ documents/ without photograph shall not be considered.
51. The applicant must ensure, before filling out the application form that there are no pending disciplinary or internal proceedings with their current employer.
52. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected. No fresh inputs will be considered after the submission of applications at any later stage.
53. The shortlisted candidates shall be conveyed on the registered email only for attending the selection process. No written or speed post communications shall be sent separately and no claims of any kind shall be entertained in this regard.
54. The last date for submission of application form is 13.04.2026 upto 05:00 PM. Applications received after the last date will not be considered and are liable to be summarily rejected.
55. Any legal proceedings in respect of any matter of claim or dispute arising out of this advertisement can be instituted only in the Court which has sole and exclusive jurisdiction at Ahmedabad / Gandhinagar (Gujarat).

Age limit and relaxation:

- Relaxation in age would be admissible as per Central Government Rules. No age relaxation will be applicable to SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates applying for Unreserved (UR) posts.
- Relaxation in age would be admissible to civilian employees working on sanctioned posts with regular pay scales of Central Govt. / State Govt. / Semi Govt. / PSU / Govt. Autonomous organization/ Statutory bodies / Govt. Universities / Govt. Research Institutes, who have rendered not less than three years regular and continuous service as on closing date and who are educationally qualified and having relevant experience. (as per OM No 15012/2/2010-Estt.(D) Dated 27/03/2012).
- Age limit for a particular category of post(s) is mentioned against each category of post.
- Relaxation in upper Age-limit admissible to eligible categories of Applicants as given below:

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EX-SERVICEMEN (ESM) APPLICANTS:

1. ESM Applicants seeking fee concession, age-relaxation and reservation, etc. shall invariably submit, the requisite Certificate from Competent Authority and also submit a Declaration as per as and when called for by the University or at the time of Document Verification, otherwise their claims for age-relaxation, reservation etc. shall not be considered.
2. The period of "Call up Service" of an Ex-Serviceman in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed Forces for purpose of age relaxation as per rules.
3. Ex-Servicemen who have already secured employment in civil side under Central Government in Group 'C' & 'D' posts on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to ex-servicemen for their re-employment are not eligible for reservation in ESM category and fee concession. However, he/ she can avail of the benefit of reservation as ex-serviceman for subsequent employment if he/ she immediately after joining civil employment, given self-declaration/ undertaking to the concerned employer about the date-wise details of applications for various vacancies for which he/ she had applied for before joining the initial civil employment as mentioned in the OM No. 36034/1/2014-Estt (Res) dated 14th August 2014 issued by DoP&T.
4. A Matriculate Ex-Serviceman (which includes an Ex-Serviceman, who has obtained the Indian Army Special Certificate of education or corresponding certificate in the Navy or the Air Force), who has put in not less than 15 years of service as on closing date of applications (i.e. 13/04/2026) with Armed Forces of the Union shall be considered eligible for appointment to the administrative posts against posts reserved for ESM only. Thus, those Matriculate Ex-Servicemen who have not completed 15 years of service as on the closing date for receipt of applications are not eligible for these posts.
5. Age-relaxation, fee concession and reservation are not admissible to sons, daughters and dependents of Ex-Servicemen. Therefore, such candidates should not indicate their category as ex-servicemen.
6. For any serviceman of the three Armed Forces of the Union to be treated as ESM for the purpose of securing the benefits of reservation etc. he / she must have already acquired, at the relevant time of submitting his/ her application for Post/ Service, the status of ESM; or is in a position to establish his/ her acquired entitlement by documentary evidence from the Competent Authority that he/ she would complete specified term of engagement with the Armed Forces within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date of applications (i.e. 13/04/2026). Such candidates must also acquire the status of an ex-serviceman within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date of application (i.e. 13/04/2026).

Ex-Servicemen: An “Ex-serviceman” means a person:

- Who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union, and
 - (a) who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; or
 - (b) who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
 - (c) who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment;

OR

- who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity, and includes personnel of the Territorial Army namely, pension holders for continuous embodies service or broken spells of qualifying service;

OR

- personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

OR

- Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987;

OR

- Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army;

OR

- Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension
